Assessment:

Students will be assessed using various methods throughout the course of the year. Some of these methods include formal written assessments, "exit tickets" (quick/brief questions before you pack up your instruments), "do-now's" (answer question written on board before you start to warm-up), etc. In addition to the assessment methods listed above, student's development/progress will be continually assessed in a rehearsal setting in addition to individualized performance assessments.

Performance Requirements:

Required Concert Attire:

Men: Black Dress Shoes, Long Black Dress Socks, Black Dress Pants (no jeans), White Button Down Long-Sleeved Dress Shirt (with collar), Tie (color of your choice).

Ladies: Black Closed-Toe Dress Shoes (no sandals or flip-flops), Black Dress Pants (no jeans or yoga pants), White Button Down Long-Sleeved Dress Shirt (with collar), and no distracting jewelry.

Necessary/Required Materials:

- At least one (1) sharpened pencil at all times in the pocket of your music folder. This pencil is band-exclusive and cannot be shared amongst your other classes.
- Each student will be assigned and given a specific band/music folder which is required at all rehearsals and performances. Students are responsible for taking proper care of this folder.
